



### Miracles Principles 25-35, Cameos 6-7

“You are the work of God, and His work is wholly lovable and wholly loving. This is how you must think of yourself in your heart, because this is what you *are*.”

- Cameo 6: Letting Him Take Care of the **Minutiae**; Miracle Principle 25
- Cameo 7: An Experience of **Revelation**; MP 28, 29
- Expressions of love (miracles) induce the experience of union with God (revelation); MP 29
- A holy responsibility; MP 26, 34
- Christ-control (miracles) and Christ-guidance (revelation); MP 35
- Impulses of the mind; MP 28

**Miracles Principles 25-35, Cameos 6-7**

**Being a miracle worker is a holy responsibility.**

- Miracles depend on timing. This is why you shouldn't waste time. (25)
- You "*must* join the Great Crusade to correct" the error (lack of love) in the world. (26)
- "The power to work miracles *belongs* to you." (26)
- "You *must* be ready and willing" to do miracles. (26)
- "The real members of my party are *active* workers." (26)
- "It is the *duty* of the released to release their brothers." (34)
- "Those released by Christ *must* join Him in releasing their brothers." (34)

# IMPULSES OF THE MIND (Miracle 28)

**CONSCIOUSNESS**  
(Higher Level)

## SUPERCONSCIOUS

### Revelation

- Is only an experience (no action) - unites us directly with God
- Involves an extremely personal sense of closeness to creation (which we try to find in sexual relationships)
- Is an end, induced by miracles which are the means

## **CONSCIOUSNESS**

(Free will is expressed here; involves action, engages in this world; is constantly bombarded with higher level and lower level impulses)



- Has no impulses of its own
- Is capable of reacting to either the super- or subconscious impulses
- Can respond to either external or internal impulses; primarily a mechanism for inducing a response; can be very wrong
- *N.B. Both Revelation and Miracles are experienced at the conscious level, although they do not emanate from consciousness*

## SUBCONSCIOUS

Induces action;

Two Levels of Subconscious Impulses

- Higher superficial level (impulses of the world; closer to consciousness)
  - Identifying with this level denies access to the miracle level underneath
- Deeper level (Miracle impulses; interpersonal – unites us directly with others)
  - Miracles place the mind in the service of the spirit
  - Miracles induce Revelation (are the means)
